



TRANSFORM HF: Peer Review Process

Peer review is a collaborative process in which a multi-disciplinary group of experts critically evaluate applications for research or award grant funding.



Launch

TRANSFORM HF launches a competition. Funding and award criteria posted publicly to our website.



Recruitment

Director recruits peer review panel members with a variety of expertise, perspectives and research experience.



Screening

Applications received and screened against qualifying criteria by Director.



Orientation

Overview of grant competition and criteria, TRANSFORM HF goals and priorities, timelines and expectations for peer review, declare conflicts of interest.



Evaluation

Each application is reviewed by PWLE, clinical, technical, and trainee reviewers, who score and comment then submit to the Director by the deadline.



Panel Meeting

Panel reviews, discusses and ranks applications, then decides funding. Director compiles anonymized comments.



Notification

Director notifies applicants of decision to fund/not fund their projects and shares reviewers' comments. Recipients confirm receipt of award and agree to terms of award/grant.



Announcement

Grant/Award recipients announced on the TRANSFORM HF website, socials and newsletter.
